- District Covid Updates/PCR Testing – Please check the Ready, Set, Go Plan the district continues to update when changes are made. Isolation Protocol: If you are vaccinated, test positive for covid, and have no symptoms you will report to work. If you test positive and have symptoms you are to quarantine. Check with Axiom and your supervisor with questions. PCR Covid testing will take place Jan. 25th at the school for students and staff only. Please fill out registration form if you are wanting to get tested. Depending on amount of people tested, most results will be given same day or within 1-2 days.
 - Safety Drills: We will have a lock down/shelter in place drill soon. We must have one each semester. We will also have fire drills once a month. Please keep up with your red safety bag and let Mrs. Lopez know if you have any questions.
 - There is money to purchase items needed for students for STAAR prep or TELPAS prep. Items purchased must follow certain guidelines due to using ESSER funds. Email Mrs. Lopez with what you would like or need and she will try to get the things for you.
 - Vacancies/2022-2023 projections – We will be getting another Teacher Assistant. The teacher assistants are helping in classes with high enrollment or with students that need extra support. For the 2022 – 2023 we are projected to have an enrollment of 380 students. WE currently have 378 students enrolled. With having around the same enrollment, we will hopefully not lose any positions, however, there may be movement from one grade level to another. We will also still receive ESSER funds for another year.
 - Spring Semester Events – We are looking at having various parent involvement nights. This may include literacy night, STEM/GT Expo, Science Fair – more details will be sent. If you have any suggestions or ideas, please let someone from SDMC or Mrs. Lopez know. Due to Covid restrictions, the various nights may not occur for every grade level and will take place at various times.
