- Principal Reed welcomed everyone to today's meeting.
- Principal Reed discussed Campus Celebrations and the campus budget in the areas of Parent Engagement, Gifted and Talented (GT), and our campus Bilingual department.
- Principal Reed stated that reviewing the Campus Action Plan was not needed at this time because all attendees were campus staff and all members agreed that they were informed on the Campus Action Plan.
- Principal Reed presented the Campus MAP growth data and answered clarifying questions that were presented by the SDMC committee.
