Action Plan & Indicators of Success (2024-25)		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Improve reading instruction in order to improve percentage of students achieving “Meets” on Reading STAAR from 55.9% in 2023 to 65% in 2025. ● Improve math and science instruction in order to improve percentage of students achieving “Meets” on Math STAAR from 60.5% in 2023 to 68% in 2025 and the percentage of students achieving “Meets” on Science STAAR from 28% in 2023 to 55% in 2025 ● Increase the percentage of tests by students with IEPs achieving “Meets” on STAAR from 24% in 2023 to 35% in 2025. ● Increase consistency in writing instruction across grade-levels and content areas to increase the percentage of students scoring 6/10 or higher on STAAR extended constructed response from 32% in 2023 to 60% in 2025. 	<i>Action Plan will be solidified by administrative team and brought forth to SDMC for approval at the beginning of next year.</i>
