SUBJECT: DECEMBER 2012 STAAR END-OF-COURSE PERFORMANCE OF RETESTERS

Houston Independent School District (HISD) has received the results for the December 2012 administration of the STAAR End-of-Course (EOC) assessments. These exams were administered to eligible students, which include students retesting as a result of a previous failure and students trying to increase a previous assessment score in fall 2012.

The data presented provides the number of students by subject who passed or failed the STAAR EOC assessment at the Phase I Standard (the state is phasing in the satisfactory standards over the next four years). Accordingly, current results reflect the scaled scores recently set by the Texas Educational Agency.

Only students who started high school in 2011–2012 or later are included in the results presented here as these are the students required to pass the exams for graduation. This report disaggregates the data provided by all testers, first time testers, previous passers, and students who had previously failed the test.

**Table 1** shows the number of students tested on each assessment, the number that failed, the average scale scores, and the percent included in each performance category for all students tested. The percentage of students who did not pass the test (Level I-Unsatisfactory (UnSat.)) is disaggregated to show the percentage who scored at the Unsatisfactory level but high enough to reach the minimum score for the test to count in their cumulative points needed for graduation. Likewise, the percentage of students who passed the test (Level II-Satisfactory (Sat.)) is disaggregated to show the percentage who scored at the highest level-Level III Advanced. Note that the percentage At Minimum (At Min.) is a subset of Unsatisfactory and that the percentage Advanced (Adv.) is a subset of Satisfactory.

- For math, Algebra I had the lowest percentages of students meeting the satisfactory standard and advanced standard with 42% and 0%, respectively, of the 2,974 assessments administered. Algebra II had the highest percentages of students meeting the satisfactory standard and advanced standard with 100% and 63%, respectively, of the eight assessments administered. For this first year, the upper level courses reflect only advanced students who are taking courses above their grade level.
- For science, only biology had more than five assessments administered in Fall 2012. The percentages of students meeting the satisfactory standard and advanced standard were 35% and 0%, respectively, of the 2,545 assessments administered.
- For social studies, world history had the highest percentages of students meeting the satisfactory standard with 52%, of the 102 assessments administered. Of the 3,510 assessments administered in world geography, 33% met the satisfactory standard, and 0% met the advanced standard.
- For English I, both reading and writing had the same percentage of students meeting the satisfactory standard, with 46% of the 4,948 reading assessments administered and 5,936 writing tests administered.
- Of the courses taken traditionally by ninth grade students, biology had the lowest satisfactory rate at 33% and geometry had the highest rate at 75% at the current phase-in standards.

**Figure 1** displays the percentage of students who achieved Satisfactory on the EOC assessments, broken up by whether the student was a first-time tester or had previously passed or failed the assessment. Students who had never taken the EOC assessment prior to fall 2012 are "First-Time Testers." Students who failed the EOC assessment every time they took it prior to fall 2012 are "Previous Failers," and students who passed the EOC assessment any time prior to fall 2012 are "Previous Passers."

- In English I Writing, the percentage of students who previously failed the EOC and who
  now achieved Satisfactory was highest of all the subjects. English I Writing was also the
  only subject to have this percentage higher than first-time testers; all other subjects showed
  the percentage of previous failers who met Satisfactory to be the lowest percentage of all
  the groups.
- In all subjects, the percentage of students who had previously passed the EOC assessment and scored at the Satisfactory level was the highest, but was lower than expected since the students had previously passed these assessments.

**Figures 2-7** show the percent of students who scored at the satisfactory level (including advanced) on each STAAR EOC assessment by secondary campus for all students tested on the retest. Within these figures, the district's percent of students who scored satisfactory is also indicated. **Appendix A** provides the number of students assessed for each subject, for each secondary campus. **Appendix B** shows the number tested and the percent who met Satisfactory by type of tester, by subject, and for each secondary campus.

## **Administrative Response**

Schools continue to work with targeted remediation to ensure the success of all students needing to test again. The High School Office is looking at a number of innovative approaches to increase the contact hours during the school day between students needing assistance and teachers. Schools are also looking into various blended learning options to offer alternative forms of instruction for students who are not successful in the regular classroom.

Figure 2: STAAR & STAAR L EOC Algebra I % Satisfactory, by Secondary Campus: Fall 2012 Retest





Figure 3: STAAR & STAAR L EOC Geometry % Satisfactory, by Secondary Campus: Fall 2012 Retest



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Figure 4: STAAR & STAAR L EOC Biology % Satisfactory, by Secondary Campus: Fall 2012 Retest





Figure 5: STAAR & STAAR L EOC World Geography % Satisfactory, by Secondary Campus: Fall 2012 Retest

Figure 6: STAAR EOC English I - Reading % Satisfactory, by Secondary Campus: Fall 2012 Retest





Figure 7: STAAR EOC English I - Writing % Satisfactory, by Secondary Campus: Fall 2012 Retest
