Let members know that Grissom was projected to be F rated and talked about passing percentages.</p> <p>Principal Kiser spoke about spring tutorial dates and interventions. Data from dibbles and state assessments would let us know to move around interventions. Poll would be sent in regard to Saturday tutorials. Teachers recommended door prizes, and making tutorials seem exclusive. STAAR Camp was recommended. Do we have enough students for transportation on Saturdays? December close out – Principal Kiser spoke about APR, Budget, Testing Data and Technology and gave a shout out to Grissom Team and families for coming together to serve the Grissom Community, Kiser let members know that she would be closing out TA positions and that Grissom should be receiving funding next semester. Grissom will purchase Clever Touch for 2nd and 3rd grade. Printers were also purchased, but the goal is for every teacher/classroom to have a printer. Paper will also be purchased. Lesson Plans must now be printed and are over 50/60 pages each. Media Specialist spoke about CSTEM program which will allow Grissom to have Debate and Film Photography. CSTEM will train teachers online. Principal Kiser's vision is for Grissom to broadcast Grissom News and for students to be leading this broadcast. Principal Kiser spoke about campus safety and let members know that building floors were currently being repaired. 2 other rooms were in the process of being worked on as well. The employee gate code was changed due to safety concerns and the open-door policy was spoken about as well as the outside lights. Principal Kiser let members know about upcoming events. Dec 15 Polar Express would take place, Dec 19 Grissom's Winter Musical would take place as well as holiday parties during the last hour of the day. Dec 21. Will be a school wide clean up to ensure everyone is out of building by 4PM. Principal Kiser spoke about campus support needed at tutorial dismissal due to altercation from the middle school across the street. Let members know if they see something, report it. If HISD Police is spotted, not to be alarmed as she requested their support in this matter. Mid-Year surveys will go out to teachers and parents next week. Principal Kiser spoke about Grissom's School Improvement Plan (SIP) Let members know that we are Diamond status, and that daily attendance is important. Overstreet spoke about the FACE walk that was conducted. Parents stated that communication at Grissom is consistent, and that Grissom is inviting and staff is friendly.
