FREE COVID-19 SCREENING TESTING FOR STUDENTS AND CAMPUS STAFF

In order to participate in the district COVID testing programming on campus, parent/guardian must first give consent.

To give consent to participate in the COVID-19 testing program, please follow these steps:

- 1. Go to <u>https://bit.ly/HISDC19Test</u> and click on the "begin" button to start the consent process.
- 2. Enter your child's student ID and select their school (if you are providing consent for more than one child, you will need to complete the form for each child).
- 3. On the following screen, please enter your child's date of birth, first name, and last name.
- 4. You will be asked to enter an email address to continue. After entering your preferred email address, you will be sent a link to confirm registration and finalize your child's





GET TEXAS!

WHAT IS IT?

GET TX (Geoscience Exposure and Training in Texas) is an opportunity for high school teachers and students to explore and gain experience in applying science and math to earth and environmental science-related problems in Southeast Texas. This National Science Foundation-funded program is run by Sam Houston State University's Dept. of Environmental and Geosciences and Lone Star College - University Park Geology. We are looking for teachers that are interested in using geoscience examples in their STEM classes and students interested in learning about a Geoscience education to help fill highpaying, in-demand jobs.

TEACHERS

Do you teach high school science, math, or other STEM courses!?

STEM teachers are encouraged to schedule a classroom visit to talk about Geoscience to learn more about the program, geoscience applications and related jobs, and get to know the faculty involved.

Each semester the program will host a teacher workshop day where university faculty will demonstrate real world applications of math, chemistry, and physics to earth science issues with activities that can be integrated into your classroom.

Participants are eligible for 1 day of Professional Development credit through TEA!

Teachers will receive a \$100 stipend for completing the workshop!

STUDENTS

Do you like science, math, or engineering!? Do you want to learn more about how you can apply these fields to solve problems related to Earth and the environment?

Join Sam Houston State University and Lone Star- University Park faculty for Open House events to learn about exciting careers in the Geosciences.

Motivated sophomore, junior, and early community college students can apply for the GET TX summer bridge program - a 10-day, immersive, lab and field experience with all meals covered and housing provided on Sam Houston State University's campus.

Bridge program students will learn directly from faculty and cover multiple geoscience issues in Southeast Texas including; basic geology, sedimentology, surface water hydrology, groundwater, and paleontology/fossils! Trips to the Houston Museum of Natural Science and Hill Country are included! Upon completion, bridge students also receive an **\$300 stipend**!

Before and after the events, participants will be asked to complete an online survey on their perceptions of the geosciences so that we can better understand the impacts of the program. Completion of the survey is not required to participate in GET TX events. 
