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Friendly Reminder about the New HISD Hazel Health Services for 2024-2025 school year

While most school nurse treatments remain the same as last year. We are so excited to announce a new physical telehealth service available with your school nurse and mental health services with our school counselor.

Through our partnership with Hazel Health, all HISD students can access virtual health care at no out-of-pocket cost to you or your family this school year. All it requires is a one-time parental consent for approval of provided health services. With your given

permission (consent), it is possible for your child to receive basic over the counter medication(s) for minor illnesses/ receive treatment/or obtain appropriate healthcare referrals through a provided telehealth visit at school or while at home during the school day. 18+ years of age students may consent for themselves to receive these services also. You do not have to have health insurance to sign up. It is not a requirement to have health insurance, but it is just included in application for gathered health information. You will never be billed for these free student health services. Please call Hazel Health with any concerning questions. 1-800-764-2935. Please go to <u>getstarted.hazel.co</u> to consent or opt out of services. We thank you for acknowledging this new HISD free health service to our HISD students and want your feedback. 

Congress-Bundestag Youth Exchange

The <u>Congress-Bundestag Youth Exchange (CBYX)</u> program provides scholarships for eligible American high school students and recent graduates to spend an academic year of study and cultural immersion in Germany. Scholarship recipients will serve as "youth ambassadors" as they gain a new perspective on global current affairs and German social, economic, and political life, all while learning the German language through language lessons, day-to-day life, attending a local high school, and living with a host family. **The deadline is November 1, 2024.**

National Security Language Initiative for Youth (NSLI-Y)

The <u>National Security Language Initiative for Youth (NSLI-Y)</u> program provides scholarships for eligible American high school students and recent graduates to learn critical languages in overseas programs. The program focuses on language instruction, while providing participants with cultural experiences in the host community and sparking a lifetime interest in languages and

cultures. Summer and academic year programs are available for Indonesian, Persian (Tajiki), Turkish, Arabic, Chinese (Mandarin), Korean, and Russian. **The deadline is November 4, 2024.**

The <u>Kennedy-Lugar Youth Exchange and Study (YES) Abroad</u> program provides scholarships for eligible American high school students and recent graduates to live with host families and attend a local high school for an academic year in Ghana, India, Indonesia, Malaysia, Thailand, Türkiye and more. Through the YES Abroad program students develop leadership skills, international competence, and an understanding of global interests and values shared across cultures. **The deadline is December 4, 2024.**


