Kennedy Lugar Youth Exchange and Study (YES) Abroad

A program of the U.S. Department of State, [the YES Abroad program](#) provides scholarships for eligible American high school students and recent graduates to live with host families and attend a local high school for an academic year in countries like Egypt, Ghana, India, Senegal, Thailand, Turkey and more. YES Abroad students promote mutual understanding between the U.S. and the host country by building relationships with the local community. National Security Language Initiative for Youth (NSLI-Y)

A program of the U.S. Department of State, [the NSLI-Y program](#) provides scholarships for eligible American high school students and recent graduates to learn one of eight critical languages: Persian, Indonesian, Hindi, Turkish, Chinese (Mandarin), Russian, Korean, and Arabic! Summer and academic year programs are available, with all programs including language instruction, cultural lessons and activities, conversation practice with local peers, and a host family component. Mile 20 Refueling Station
Set up and distribute Gatorade and water to the full marathon runners on Memorial near the Woodway intersection. Clean up after the last runner passes. Wear weather appropriate clothing and comfortable shoes. Check-in at 6:45 am at the refueling station location near the intersection of Memorial and Woodway. Several days prior to the event, your station captain will contact you by email with final instructions, such as parking suggestions.

Shift description:
Set up and distribute Gatorade and water to the half marathon runners on Montrose at the intersection with Willard and Bonmar. Clean up after the last runner passes. Wear weather appropriate clothing and comfortable shoes. Show up at 6:30 AM at the refueling station location at the intersection of Montrose and Bonmar. Several days prior to the event, your station captain will contact you by email with final instructions, such as parking suggestions.
