Minutes:

Michelle Sacks called the meeting to order. Attendees introduced themselves. The minutes were read. Kim Lopez approved the minutes and Rosangella Espinosa seconded.

Safety Update:

Officer Mott shared information about the nine programs that the Houston Police Department has in HISD including Teens and Police Service (TAPS), Youth Police Advisory Council (YPAC), Greater Houston Police Activities League (GHPAL), Explorers, My Brother's Keeper. Descriptions of each program can be found here: <https://www.houstontx.gov/police/youth-programs.htm> At the YPAC orientation, students cited mental health as the most important issue affecting them.

Social Media Update:

Felicia reminded members to share photos and information to post with Jenny Moreno.

Nutrition Services Update:

Nan Cramer reported that salad bars returned on Tuesday in elementary, K-8 and high schools. Thanksgiving lunch will be on Thursday, November 17. Many schools will invite parents. Field trips to Mykawa Farm have begun and more are scheduled throughout the year. A farmers' market will be held at Hattie Mae White administration building on Friday, December 2nd from 11 am to 1 pm. A fruit tree planting event will be at Mykawa Farm on November 12. Schools were invited to get a tree for their school or community.

Health and Medical Services Update:

Felicia shared that COVID testing will begin on November 7th at schools. Details are on the HISD website <https://www.houstonisd.org/COVIDTestingFAQ>. HISD is seeking partners for the Period Positivity program. Let Felicia know if you know of anyone that can donate feminine products. The COVID Dashboard wastewater reports now track RSV, Flu and COVID.

Social and Emotional Learning Update:

Bea Marquez reported that October was National Bullying Prevention Month. Superintendent House attended and event at Fondren Middle School. SEL trainings are on-going. SEL spent 200 hours of support at 229 campuses and 1220 interactions such as behavior support, campus needs assessments and walk throughs.

Health and Physical Education Update:

Felicia reported that Project Adventure Outdoors held a camping trip in Galveston with Rusk and Piney Point. 2023 Youth Risk Behavior Survey (YRBS) will be administered in February 2023 with 12th grade. YRBS 2021 data is being analyzed and results available as infographics and school profiles. CDC will do a site visit next week for the Advocates for Youth program. Youth and Adult Partnerships did a professional development with 15-18 staff and teachers. The PD focused on being trusted adults and how to lead clubs. The sensory classroom at Tijerina ES is almost complete. The classroom is funded by the CDC, and it includes iPads, sensory objects and it will be open in January.

Health Curriculum Update:

The review of the health curriculum began one year ago and included several program reviews. New Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills (TEKS) and student learning outcomes required new textbook resources which were state approved. The textbooks were reviewed by teachers and the information was provided to the board. Now parents are invited to review the resources and provide feedback. Michelle Sacks sent an email with the information. The parent opt-in letter is posted. November 11 is the deadline for parents to submit feedback.

Program Reviews:

No programs submitted for review this semester. March 8 is the date for the spring program review.

Parent/Community Sharing:

Michelle shared that the Houston Area Woman's Center (HAWC) has two team members working in the east end of Houston and one team member in the Sunnyside neighborhood. All HISD schools are invited to the first educational roundtable on Human Trafficking on December 1.

Beverly Marlin shared that Riverside Methodist in the 3rd Ward will have three food giveaways.
