

Inclusive Access Program

HCC partners with Barnes & Noble to provide Textbook Savings program to students. The Program offers lower-cost textbooks to students compared to national textbook prices. The cost of the books is assessed upon registration. The dual credit waiver will not cover the costs of the books, rather the balance will need to be paid by the student. Below are a few notes about the program.

- Electronic textbooks (eBooks) are accessible to students on the first day of class.
- Students may opt-out of the electronic textbook prior to the Official Day of Record see below to receive full reimbursement at the time of scheduled refund.

Regular Term (RT) – Official Day of Record - 1/30/2023

First 8 Weeks (F8A) Official Day of Record – 1/23/2023

Second 8 Weeks (F8B) Official Day of Record – 3/27/2023

Second Start (SS) – Official Day of Record - 2/22/2023
