Purpose:

*The purpose of the meeting was to discuss campus events: Mr. Johnson discussed campus safety, Title 1, family engagement and testing.

- Greeting (Mr. Johnson)
- Translation (April Ortiz Parent) Mrs. Ortiz provided the Spanish translation for Spanish speaking parents.
- Introduction of members
- Campus Safety- I discussed the current number of in-school-suspensions and out-of-school-suspensions. Compared to January 2022, there was a significant decrease in both categories. I explained to the parents that instead of suspension, students were assigned after-school detention in place of suspension for lesser infractions.
- Title 1-The budget for Title-1 was discussed with the parents. Specifically, I explained that there were specific Title-1 funds that were prioritized for parent engagement. Ms. Fisher, Title-1 coordinator encouraged parents to join the SDMC as well as brainstorm ideas on how support parents.
- Family Engagement-*Possip* was the topic of discussion. *Possip* is a parent engagement tool where parents can answer two questions regarding the school. There are three categories that parents can leave feedback, cool, warm, hot. Parents can leave feedback anonymous or with contact information attached.
- Testing-I provided the parents with the spring testing calendar. I explained to the parents that there would be heavy testing. I also informed the parents that all testing is on-line for the students. Implications for the next meeting would be discussing the data from the latest district-wide assessment.
