As we assist our students in the crucial step of becoming *college-ready* we invite all instructors to activate and join <u>Khan Academy</u>. Khan Academy is a non-profit educational organization that provides free online courses, lessons, and practice in a wide range of subjects.

The platform offers resources in areas such as math, science, economics, history, and more, catering to learners of all ages. The interactive content includes instructional videos, practice exercises, and a personalized learning dashboard to help students progress at their own pace.

Khan Academy's digital SAT prep, as well as other online courses, is a free online resource designed to help students to prepare for the SAT/TSIA, particularly the digital version of the exam(s).

To get started, please review the action steps below:

1. <u>Activate your Teacher account</u> using **Clever**. Teachers who have access to Clever can log into Khan Academy by clicking the **Khan Academy icon**. Additionally, **select "Create a new account"** (students will access their accounts the same way).



Note: All HISD teachers have been previously rostered therefore single sign-on should be available. If you already have a Khan Academy account, you should select log-in > Continue with Clever.

2. On your **teacher dashboard**, you will be able to <u>confirm your student rosters</u> for each of your classes. Students have been previously rostered to your classes via PowerSchool and should appear in Khan Academy class rosters.

- 3. As instructors you will be able to <u>monitor your students' independent practice progress</u>. We recommend students practice skills on Khan Academy a minimum of 45 minutes each week. Student Engagement in Khan can be facilitated in:
 - a. ELA & Math classrooms (supplemental resource for teacher-created assignments)
 i. SAT Prep Focus: English 3 and Algebra 2 students
 - b. Advisory or Advocacy class sessions
 - c. GradLab
 - d. Independent study/practice at home

As we implement the use of this incredible tool, more directives and training regarding assigning skills, courses and other features are forthcoming.
