### **Welcome & Member Introduction**

Mr. Collins began the meeting at 3:30 pm. He welcomed the community members and SDMC members and opened the floor for introductions.

#### **I. Scholastic Book Fair**

Mr. Collins informed the committee about the success of the Scholastic Book Fair. Parents and students were able to purchase books and other items before school, during their magnet period and after school. This is first book fair in the last 3 years.

#### **I. PEIMS Snapshot Oct. 28 Final Enrollment; Staff Position updates per impact; Current Vacancies**

Mr. Collins explained that we were 100 students short of our projected enrollment of 450 students for the 2022-2023 school year. He explained how the shortage decreased his budget by \$200,000 which resulted in the loss of a second-grade teacher. We are still in need of a certified first grade teacher.

Ms. Lanier, Magnet Coordinator and Mr. Collins will be attending a job fair on Saturday, November 12, 2022, at Hattie Mae White Building from 9am – Noon, to recruit for one first grade teacher and Special Ed. BSC teacher.

#### **III. 2022-2023 SIP & CIP**

Mr. Collins informed the committee that the English version of the SIP has been uploaded to the website, but we are awaiting Spanish translation to be uploaded in the near future. Mr. Collins explained that we are a Title 1 school, and we are giving certain funding because of it. He explained that the CIP is an activity fund used to pay for things such as buses for field lessons and other campus activities. The updated CIP is due on November 18, 2022.

Mr. Collins opened the floor for Q and A. Ms. Alcantar asked if we knew of any places giving our Turkeys. Mr. Collins responded by informing her that Mr. Osborne, Wraparound Specialist, is working with community partners to deliver Turkey dinners for 20 of our families here at the Garden.

Mr. Collins provided an update regarding Christmas schedule and planning an employee Holiday Fellowship at Pappas.
