Meeting notes	<p>We discussed the key actions from the action plan</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Discussed why the goal percentage is 95% for English and Spanish classroom overall for math- We are linked to a sister school which is Windsor village. Our rating is directly correlated to theirs- Progress monitor to see where the students are before thanksgiving break and spring break to help bring up the math/literacy scores- Talked about the connection to attendance, if students aren't here or are late they miss out on instruction- 80% English and 85% Spanish for alliteration- Building MRS strategies for 100% student engagement and building processing and critical thinking skills- Parent asked how we can measure the MRS if there is no percentage, Principal let them know that it will be monitored through spot observations/teacher evaluations- We discussed the process for evaluating and reaching the needs according the students IEP- Discussed the limitations on meeting because of the conflicting schedules to meet with parents and the other individuals that need to be present for meetings (ARDs or IATs)
