Meeting Highlights:

P-TECH (Pathways in Technology Early College High Schools) Updates

- Jones and Wheatley submitted a grant to TEA for designation as a P-TECH school. Jones and Wheatley will be the only P-TECH schools in the District. Jones will retain its current pathways and designation as a Magnet school.
- On the HVAC side the school will have open enrollment; there will be no qualifying Matrix score.
- Open HVAC side starting with 9th grade; maximum number of students for enrollment is 75
- Will retain Early College and Dual Credit
- Have one year to plan to open for 9th grade.
- · Grant funds a Grant Coordinator for 2 years
- · Grant Coordinator will help build the program
- Will go from Level 1 to HCC certificate
- More information to come after 5/28/21 meeting
- · Want to recruit more students
- Goal of this implementation is to expand the school's enrollment and opportunities for scholars
- Great opportunity for students
