Welcome/Introduction of Members

School Safety

Crocs must be in sports mode. Dresses must be at least to the bend of the knee, and sagging pant are not allowed. The SDMC committee approved the dress code for the 2023-2024 school year.

All ESSER positions will be cut for the 2023-2024 school year. There is a district proposal to decrease small school allotment and cut the hold harmless attendance policy.

The current bell schedule will remain in place. ADA time is 9:45. The 2023-2024 bell schedule was approved by the SDMC committee.

Currently, there are two vacancies: Computer class and Biology class.

Attendance is still low at 84%. The attendance rate will be used to determine the budget for the upcoming school year.

Enrollment is down. At snapshot it was 960. It's currently at 921. Ms. Adams said, she has a plan to increase enrollment. She's planning an upcoming event for students who do not attend North Forest.

School safety is always a priority. North Forest administrators continue to discuss safety rules with students and staff. The doors to the classrooms remain closed and locked during instruction. The windows are covered with dark paper. The district is planning a mandated unannounced lockdown drill. Legislatures are proposing funding for safety resources.
