Tracking College Admissions and Scholarship Offers

Every year we track data related to the college application and admission process. This ensures we continue to improve and ensures Lamar students have great opportunities as they move from high school into college and career. At this time 71% of our current seniors have applied to a 4-year college (95% of the Top 25% of the class and 99% of the Top 10% of the class). We are a bit behind our goal on submitting FAFSA, with only 33% of our students making the priority deadline. FAFSA evaluates eligibility for financial aid for students. Starting **Monday**, **January 28**, text notifications will ending for Verizon Wireless customers who use the free Remind service.

- If you communicate with your class on Remind: People who normally get your Remind messages as texts may no longer receive them.
- If you have Verizon Wireless as you phone carrier: You'll no longer receive Remind text notifications. To get messages, you'll need to turn on smartphone or email notifications instead.
- If you have a Remind School and District plan: This service disruption won't affect your organization.

Why the Verizon fee affects free text messaging on Remind

To offer our text messaging service free of charge, Remind has always paid for each text that users receive or send. Now, Verizon is charging Remind an additional fee intended for companies that send spam over its network.

Your Remind messages aren't spam, but that hasn't helped resolve the issue with Verizon. The fee will increase our cost of supporting text messaging to at least 11 times our current cost--forcing us to end free Remind text messaging for the more than 7 million students, parents, and educators who have Verizon Wireless as their carrier.

The National Honor Society applications are open!

The National Honor Society is an organization dedicated to community service, academic excellence, strong character, and leadership. Members of the Lamar NHS chapter are required to complete 12 hours of service per semester (6 of which must be completed through service events provided by Lamar NHS) and attend meetings every other Tuesday. NHS members have the opportunity to demonstrate leadership within the organization by applying to be a Junior Officer as a junior or an Officer as a senior.

Students can find the application on <u>lamarnhs.org</u> and must submit their application by February 24th. If you are already a member, you do need to reapply.

To be considered for admission you must:

- be a current sophomore or junior
- have a GPA of 3.7 or above
- complete the online application including essay submitted to <u>turnitin.com</u>
