### Track and Field

#### Day 1:

The girls had **Alil Akbar and Kaycee Green** qualify for the finals of the 400 meters. **Diara Overton-Bivins, Paris Powers, and Amanda Smith** qualified for the finals of the 100 meters. **Overton-Bivins, Smith, and Marion Rutherford** all qualified for the finals of the 200 meters.

The boys have 9 athletes that have already qualified for the Area Championships. **Kaleb Goodley** won the high jump and qualified along with **Preston Pierre** who placed third. **Omarion Marshall** qualified by placing 2<sup>nd</sup> in the long jump and triple jump. **Reynolds Delgardo** finished second in the pole vault and qualified for the Area Meet. **Cam Vandible** qualified in the triple jump with a third place finish. Other qualifiers included **Nehemiah Johnson** in shot put, **Jeremiah Sanks** in long jump, and **Aaron Kizzee** in the discus.

#### Day 2:

The second night of the district 18-6A championships was dominated by our Lamar squad. The boys competed in the prelims of the sprint events where **Ayden Turner**, **Caleb Thomas**, and **Chris Boykins** all qualified for the 100 meters. **Bailey Hashmi and Jayden House** qualified for the 200 meters. **Ryan Johnson and Edgar Nunez** qualified for the 400 meters. **Cam Vandible**, **Rico Moore**, and **Christian Wooten** all qualified for the 300 Hurdles.

The girls events featured the Lamar girls taking care of business and qualifying for the Area Championships.

Anika Clark-Desai was one of the first qualifiers with her first place finish in the pole vault. Also winning gold and qualifying for the Area Championships was Tatiana Nwosu in the shot put, followed by Taylor Morrison with a second place finish in the shot. In the long jump Chi Ibekwe, Imari Dean, and Prynces Robinson all qualified for the area meet as they got second, third, and fourth respectively. The triple jump also saw a second, third, fourth finish for the Lamar girls as Chi Ibekwe, Phoenix Sneed, and Imari Dean all qualified for the area meet. The girls distance group also had

## **STAAR EOC Exams**

STAAR EOC exams will be administered on the dates listed below. All students are required to take and pass the five STAAR End of Course (EOC) exams before graduating. All STAAR exams are administered through the online testing platform and students will test on their HISD issued laptop. If your child's laptop or charger is missing or broken, it is critical that they go to the Lamar IT Office (N215) immediately. If your child's laptop charger is missing s/he will need to purchase a new charger through the Lamar Business Office or using the SchoolPay at this link. Please note that all students are responsible for returning a laptop, charger and case at the end of the school year.

Practice Online STAAR EOC exams can be viewed <a href="here">here</a> The STAAR test does not have a time limit this year. Students will have until the end of the school day to finish their test, if needed.



# **Attention Juniors and Seniors**

## IB Annual Fee 2022-2023 Are Past Due

All 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> graders taking one or more IB classes are required to pay an <u>annual</u> \$90 IB fee.

11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade IB course names end in SL and HL. If you see SL or HL on your child's schedule, your child is in an IB course.

This fee supports:

IB tests, IB materials, digital resources, and teacher trainings for our IB programs and if earned the **graduation stole.** 

The actual fee that HISD pays to the IB is \$119 per course. When a student tests in five IB courses, HISD pays the IB \$595.

The annual fee of \$90 is past due.

Students who are identified as economically disadvantaged may pay \$30. You can make your annual payment through School Pay or in person at the Lamar business office.


