Principal's Corner



Seniors – Here is what you need to know about final exams!

Final Examinations Regulations

- ☐ A student cannot retake a final exam to improve his/her grade.
- ☐ No final examination will be required in any course in which credit is not awarded. The final average in such courses will be computed from the cycle grades.
- ☐ In HISD, a final examination will be required in all state and local credit courses, including PE and electives, except second semester seniors who qualify for an exemption.

To be exempted from final examinations in second (spring) semester senior students must have:

- Senior (12th grade) classification;
- 85 average or better in course;
- S or E conduct average; and
- No more than three (3) total absences not including ADA exemptions.

Senior exam dates will be confirmed next week. Stay tuned!

Freshmen, Sophomores, Juniors – Excessive Absences

If you have more than four absences in any course for the spring semester, you should be banking hours for credit appeal. Each absence (excused or unexcused) above four, requires 90-minutes of credit appeal. Students will have only 5 days between the end of the semester and the deadline for resolving NGs due to excessive absences. Anything not resolved by the end of day on June 14th will automatically require summer school attendance to get credit for the course. Summer school begins June 17 and goes through July 19, 2024.

Important Spring Testing Updates

STAAR EOC Exams

STAAR EOC exams will be administered on the dates listed below. All students are required to take and pass the five STAAR End of Course (EOC) exams before graduating. All STAAR exams are administered through the online testing platform and students will test using their HISD issued laptop. If your child’s laptop or charger is missing or broken, it is critical that they go to the Lamar IT Office (N215) immediately. If your child’s laptop charger is missing s/he will need to purchase a new charger through the Lamar Business Office or using SchoolPay at [this link](#) . Please note that all students are responsible for returning a laptop and charger at the end of the school year.

Practice Online STAAR EOC exams can be viewed [here](#). All STAAR EOC tests will begin at 8:30 AM. Rosters will be posted in the hallway telling students where to report for testing. The STAAR test is not timed, so students have until the end of the school day to finish their test, if needed. All students not testing will follow a regular bell schedule.

Advanced Placement (AP) Exams

Students taking an AP class during the fall semester have been registered to take the AP exam on the date listed below. Students enrolled in AP classes are required to take the corresponding AP exam as part of the course requirements. Houston ISD has paid the registration fee for our students to take these exams. As a result, any student not taking the required AP exam will be charged a \$40 non-use fee by the College Board. AP students should check their MyAP account for additional testing information.

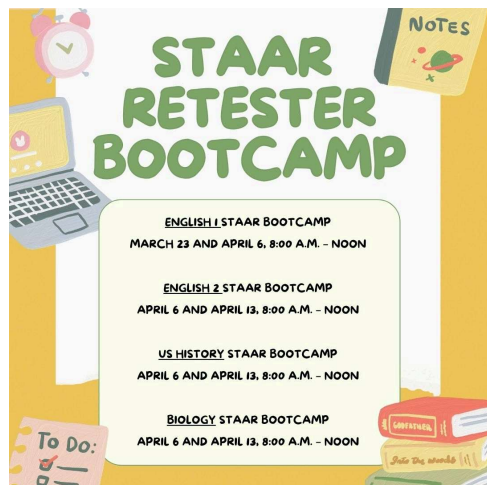



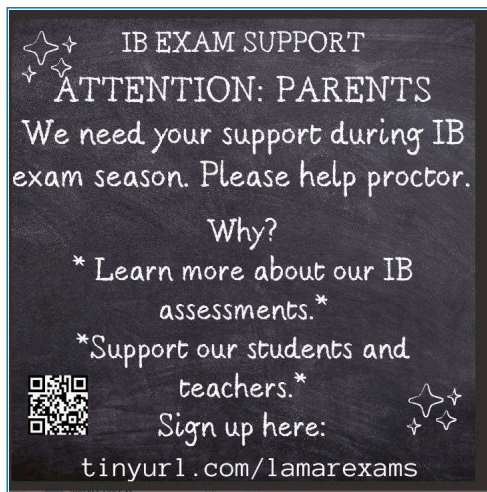
Backpacking thru Barcelona

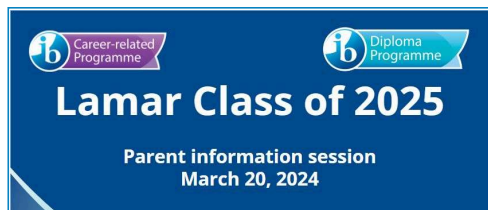
