Students with NGs will be required to retake the class to graduate.

Concerns from Our Neighbors

Over the last two weeks I have received an uptick in complaints from our neighbors – residential and commercial. It is important to me that we are good neighbors, and that we are representing Lamar with the highest levels of character.

I would like to ask for your help with these few things:

- Please use the carpool lane in the Transit Center for drop-off and pick-up. The line queues in the right lane of Westheimer headed East from Buffalo Speedway and then turns South on Eastside Drive.
- Please do not park along the neighborhood streets or in the shopping strip parking lot across the street to pick-up in the afternoon.
- Students should stay on the sidewalks and cross at the crosswalks when walking to and from school. It is
 extremely dangerous to cross Westheimer at Eastside. It is not designated as a crossing zone by the city.
- Students should not enter the residential properties (front yards, courtyards, backyards) in the neighborhood.
- Students should remain on campus throughout the school day. We are advising businesses not to allow Lamar students on the premises during school hours unless they are with a parent or guardian.
- When visiting local merchants after school, remember that you represent Lamar. Please show them our best!



Student Ambassador Leadership Opportunity




