- There is a fee for the summer school class, which will be determined by the district late in the Spring semester.

## FAQs

- Where do we enter?** Garage entrance, 2nd Floor Athletic Lobby
- Can we park in the garage?** Yes! Even if you do not have a parking permit, please park in the garage.
- What if I forget my student ID?** You will not be allowed in. If you have misplaced your ID, see the Clerk immediately!
- What if I forget my ride waiver?** There will be extra copies at check-in. However, if you are not 18 years old, you will not be able to sign and will not receive a ride wristband.
- If we leave early, can we come back in?** No re-entry allowed.
- What if I arrive late?** There will be no late entry after 8:30. DO NOT BE LATE.
- Can I bring a bag?** Yes, but it must be clear & no larger than 4" x 6".
