- · Attend all class periods to ensure you don't lose credit because of attendance.
- Turn in all doctor's notes.
- Turn in all assignments your teacher will still accept. It is an opportunity to bump your grade up and improve your GPA.
- Study for your final exam. It is another opportunity to bump your grade up and improve your GPA.
- All APEX courses will be wiped out before summer school begins. If you have APEX courses that you are more than 50% done with, close them out this week and you may avoid having to attend summer school.
- If you have NGs from the first or second semester, watch for information from your grade level administrators. We will offer credit appeal on June 9-11 for students who need to clear NGs from this school year. After June 11, any NGs remaining will result in you will be seated in summer school to retake the course.

Notice for Students on Transfers

Students who are attending Lamar on a CTE or Magnet transfer are required to pass their CTE or magnet class to maintain their transfer. These courses are not available to retake through summer school. Students who did not pass their CTE or Magnet course will be notified of a plan for retaking the course next school year. If at any point the student is no longer able to complete the pathway and graduate on time, the transfer will not be renewed for the next school year. Please watch for notifications.

Students interested in participating in the IB Diploma Program or IB Math classes in 11th and 12th grades – this message is for YOU!

• In order to take the IB Math classes in 11th and 12th grades, students must have completed Algebra 1, Geometry, and Algebra 2 before 11th grade.

• Students currently in Algebra 1 as 9th graders have the opportunity to take Geometry at Lamar HS in summer school, with a grade review and approval by their Academic Dean.

• There MAY BE a fee for the summer school class, which will be determined by the district late in the Spring semester.

Testing Updates

AP Exams –

Any student who missed their AP exam will be charged the \$40 College Board Non-Use Fee. Students should check their email and AP Classroom for any outstanding fees.

IB Exams –

We have one more week of IB testing. Please check the <u>Lamar HS Testing Calendar</u> for all upcoming testing dates. Any student who does not take their IB exam on the assigned date will be charged a \$25 No Sit Fee. All fees must be paid before students can be cleared for graduation.

- Students must be classified as a 12th or 11th grader by the registrar for the 2025-2026 school year.
- Online applications must be completed.
- Applicants must have a Current Texas Driver License or Valid Texas Learners Permit to apply.
- If applications exceed the number of parking permits available a lottery will be held to distribute parking spots with incoming
 - 12th graders given priority over incoming 11th graders if students apply before the deadline of midnight on June 10th.

APPLICATIONS MUST BE SUBMITTED BY MIDNIGHT MONDAY JUNE 10TH 2025.

Once approved you must submit all required paperwork by Midnight June 30 to secure your parking permit.

After the deadline apply to the Parking Waitlist.

SPRING 2025 Final Exam Exemptions

Final-ly!

Students in grades 9-11 will be able to earn exemptions from final exams – High School Course exemptions or College-level Course exemptions.

Final Exam Exemptions – All High School Courses

To incentivize the daily attendance rate, eligible grade 9 students may be allowed one spring final exam exemption; two spring final exam exemptions may be allowed for eligible 10th and 11th graders. Eligible students are those with:

- no more than three (3) absences in any one course for the duration of the semester;
- an S or E in conduct; and
- must have an 85 or higher semester average in the specific course(s) where the final exam exemption is applied.

Final Exam Exemptions for College-Level Courses

Schools may, under the following conditions, exempt students in grades 9 -12 from a final exam in college-level courses, defined as IB SL or HL or Advanced Placement (AP):

- if the student takes the AP or IB exam for the assigned course;
- an S or E in conduct; and
- a course average of 85 or better in the specific course(s) where the final exam exemption is applied.

11th and 12th grade students in IB courses must submit all IB assessments, sit for IB exams in May, and participate in all oral assessments. To be exempt from finals in 11th and 12th grade IB courses, students must also have all IB assessments complete.

Graduation Information

Check-in Procedures

- Graduates park in the Blue Lot and enter through the Ford gate.
- Graduates will turn right and enter the Phillips 66 entrance. Graduates must arrive 4:30PM for check-in .
- Upon arrival, graduates will be required to pass through weapon detectors or undergo screening with security wands.
- School representatives will guide graduates to line up and proceed to their designated seats.

Dress Code Requirements

- Caps and gowns are mandatory for entry into the ceremony.
- Appropriate attire must be worn under academic regalia.
- Modest heels are recommended, as graduates will navigate steps and ramps.

Approved Accessories

Graduates may wear the following accessories:

- Academic medals.
- · Honor cords representing academic excellence, or honor societies.
- HISD ribbons awarded for specific accomplishments.
- IB/NHS stoles approved by the campus principal or designee.
- Decorated or personalized graduation caps with prior approval from the principal or designee.

Additional Information

- Electronic devices, including cell phones, are not permitted on the venue floor.
- For cap and gown orders, please contact your campus graduation representative.
- Students are responsible for obtaining their own graduation announcements.

Tickets, Seating, and Parking

- NRG Stadium: No ticket required. Children must be seated with a responsible adult. Graduates do not need a ticket to enter the venue from the graduate entrance.
- Seating for all ceremonies will begin one hour before the assigned ceremony start time.
- Graduates and Guest will park in the Blue Lot.
- HISD police and additional law enforcement will be available to direct traffic in and out of the graduations.
- Graduates and guests are responsible for the \$25.00 parking fee plus tax (debit or credit card only).
- When arriving at NRG Stadium, guests will enter **gate 9** on Kirby Drive. Officers and the parking attendants will direct traffic in and out of the graduations. Guests will enter at the Bud Light Plaza and turn left towards the Ford entrance.



Behavioral Expectations

Campus leadership will clearly communicate expectations for student behavior and decorum during all phases of the graduation ceremony – including assembly and line-up, the processional and recessional, and while crossing the stage. These guidelines should specifically prohibit poses, flips, dances or hand gestures other than a handshake when accepting the diploma. Families are urged to reinforce these guidelines with their graduates to ensure full participation in this important occasion and to avoid any actions that could result in being removed from the stage or ceremony.

Safety

HISD Police and additional law enforcement will be on-hand for security and traffic control during the graduation ceremony. First aid stations will be onsite for any medical needs. HISD employees will need to present their employee ID badge.

Bag Policy and Screening Measures

In keeping with HISD's core value of student safety, all graduates and guests will be required to pass through weapon detectors and/or be screened with security wands. To expedite movement of guests through the lines to enter the facilities, guests are encouraged not to bring any bags. If a bag is necessary, then consider a bag that is clear (size recommendation no larger than 12" x 6" x12") or carry a small clutch purse (size recommendation 4.5" x 6.5"), approximately the size of a hand. All bags are subject to search upon entry.

Prohibited Items

Bringing prohibited items or engaging in inappropriate behavior may result in denied entry or removal from the venue. The following are not allowed:

- · Disorderly conduct
- · Smoking or vaping
- Alcohol or drugs
- · Firearms, explosives, or weapons
- Laser pointers, drones
- · Littering or use of glitter
- Noisemakers (e.g., air horns, cowbells, whistles)
- Flowers, bouquets, balloons, signs, banners, flags, beach balls, confetti, or streamers
- · Any item obstructing another guest's view
- Outside food and drinks (exception: clear water bottles as needed for health reasons)
- Wandering into restricted areas
- · Any item deemed inappropriate by Houston ISD staff
