This week our 11th graders will be taking part in a hands-on, design opportunity fondly referred to as Group 4. Group 4 is an experiment that all students seeking an IB Diploma must complete. The Group 4 experiment is a personal investigation into the sciences with an emphasis on biology, chemistry, and physics. These experiments encourage students to make meaningful connections to real world impacts. As has been Lamar High's tradition, students travel to the University of Houston to conduct their experiments in the science teaching laboratories.

This year's Group 4 experiment challenges students to optimize the design of simple batteries. Battery technology is an active area of research because it's potential for storing renewable energy could allow for decreased carbon consumption. Starting with a simple battery in the lab, students can expand upon their practical experience to better understand and meet the energy challenges the world is facing.

Students will be transported to UH this week to conduct their experiments, gather their data, develop a presentation, and return to Lamar where they will present their findings to their peers.
