Daily Classroom Walkthroughs

In an ongoing effort to guarantee high quality instruction in every classroom, administrators will perform daily walkthroughs focusing on lesson plan and instruction alignment to the TEKS, data driven instruction, instructional strategies including workstations, read- alouds, small group instruction, mini lessons, and exit tickets. Teachers will receive constructive feedback/suggestions from administrators and follow-up observation.

Student Assessments

The High Frequency Word Evaluation will be administered is now being administered, November 2 – November 19, to 1st and 2nd grade students. Along with HFWE, teachers are preparing students for the 2nd Literacy by 3 Running Records. Our library clerk has scheduled all students in 1st -5th grade to practice reading via Accelerated Reader. Billy Reagan K-8 purchased Accelerated Reader during the schools opening and has continued to renew the license. It has proven to be an effective instructional tool to help students reach grade level reading proficiency.

After School Tutorials and School Day Interventions

By analyzing data from Snapshots and campus benchmark assessments, teachers and administrators have identified students most in need of intensive intervention in specific content areas. School day interventions have been implemented to target students lacking prerequisite skills. Mathematics, specifically problem solving, is of greatest concern at Reagan K-8. Parent information meeting continue to take place to parents up to date on academic concerns and provide strategies parents can use at home to provide assistance to their children.
