- State of the School:
 - o Enrollment: 10/27/2023 730 Students (-5 ADA speech)
 - PreK- 25; K- 89; 1st- 133; 2nd- 123; 3rd- 124; 4th-112; 5th- 116
 - Budget: About \$3500 per student; Prek is ½ funded \$1750 per student
 - **\$2,450,000 + \$43,750 = \$2,493,750**
 - 80% spent on Staff salaries = \$1,995,000
 - Approximately \$11,000 has been spent on substitutes. Classes may need to be split up to save money when a teacher is absent.
 - -\$57,000 (at risk \$ is missing)
 - Teachers will receive one case of paper to keep in room. No paper will be purchased until possibly January. Teachers should request paper on Amazon Wish Lists and on class newsletters.
- GT Testing: Process has been changed for parents to request testing. Ms. Mouton will notify teachers and parents as information becomes available. Testing will hopefully begin November 10, 2023. Waiting on list from the GT department.
- Instruction: Mr. Shankle went over the instructional mandates for the classroom.

 - Visuals
 - Timers
 - SEL
 - Common assessments every month
 - PLCs weekly
 - Tier 1 for all students (grade level instruction)
 - Intervention program in each grade level
 - Teachers are confident and effective.
 - MRS strategies: Read Write Think 95% of the time (every 4 minutes)
 - Classroom management
 - Don't waste time during transitions.
 - Bell to bell teaching
 - 100% engagement
 - No earning of free time
 - No Crayola curriculum
