Using Results

Individuals who give constructive feedback are going out on a limb and typically don't want to hurt people's feelings

Staff must be able to trust that the person(s) receiving the feedback will act on it in the spirit in which it was given, without fear of retribution.

Feedback represents the reality of the situation or the individual's perception of reality.

If you agree that something is broken, than you can start to work on it.
If you don't agree with the feedback, then there's work to be done to change perceptions.

Recognize the effort to provide constructive feedback
Frame what you are hearing by stepping into the shoes of the individual giving the feedback

Resist tendency to shift to solving problems
Instead ask questions, listen and learn
