### Meeting Minutes Tuesday, November 12, 2024

- I. Meeting Called to Order at 3:45
- II. Previous minutes are approved.
- III. Old Business
  - a. Campus Action Plan: deadline has been extended, however our plan is finalized. No further edits will be made and Dr. Welch has approved the action plan. During Principal's meeting tomorrow, the action plan will be visited and accomplishments will be highlighted as well as pending actions. We are on target. Instructional practices, admin capacities, and closing achievement gap were primary actions.
  - b. School Mural: Tara Bradley is here with her team to work on the mural project for the next 3-4 weeks. Students have been able to talk with the team about their work.
  - c. Master schedule: Current schedule is not functioning equitably. Admin is working on creating equal or equitable minutes within blocks and odd transition times. The primary focus is instructional time. Integrating magnet into the day is not primary focus.
- IV. New Business
  - a. October Snapshot- 883 was the projection, 927 is the snapshot total. The projected budget settle up is \$259,579. This is being added to the budget.

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- b. Braintrust Board has been formed. The Braintrust Board consists of teacher leaders and representatives from all areas of the campus.
  - i. With the new budget, the Braintrust board has made requests for resources and staffing.
  - ii. Carlock will no longer be a testing coordinator, so a new role will be created under the Teacher Specialist position.
  - iii. Additional TAs for each grade level hallway and in SPED.
  - iv. Dyslexia hourly lecturer will be returning.
  - v. All resources and staffing has been approved, now admin will start hiring. Hopefully, we will have a full staff when we return from winter break.
  
- c. First IRT – visited 8 teachers, primarily in ELA were visited (5 classrooms).
  - i. Admin visited with each teacher that was visited.
  - ii. Mr. Carter was not in agreement with individual teacher scores.
  - iii. Mr. Carter reached out to executive director and senior executive director, who were also surprised by certain scores.
  - iv. Division Superintendent was contacted, and she will issue feedback to the Leadership and Strategic Initiatives team. She will also be coming for a campus visit.
  - v. West Division was scored Proficient 1 at a 9.12 and district as a whole was 9.0.
  
- d. Side discussion about MAP scores for ELA being lower across the district.
