

STUDENT DRESS CODE:

Please be mindful of Lyons Student Dress Code. See the exert below and discuss with your children about what is not permitted. Parents will be called to bring appropriate clothing/shoes. (The completed Student Dress Code can be found in the Student Handbook.)

STUDENT DRESS CODE

The Code of Student Conduct describes a broad range of behavior considered student misconduct. We believe in providing your child high quality instruction and your support is essential to a positive learning environment:

1. Students should be fully clothed, neat, and clean.
2. Students must always wear shoes for their own safety and protection. **Crocs, Slippers, flip-flops, sandals, clogs, and high heels are *not permitted*.**
3. Mini-skirts and mini-dresses are unacceptable. **Skirts/skorts and shorts length must be *no shorter than 3 inches above the knee*.**
4. **Pants and shorts *should not be distressed nor have ripped holes*.** They should not be skintight. **Leggings and bicycle shorts may not be worn.** Shorts must be no shorter than 3 inches above the knee.


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RESCHEDULED BAND CONCERT:
