<p>Final Budget Update FY 2023</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • General Fund at \$26,000 and State Comp at \$22,000 • Title I Budget at \$16,000 but \$14,000 will be used to purchase chromebooks with a capital outlay request • \$3,500 School wide budget on EOY activities including field day, EOY production/performance, Ceremonies, and field trips.
