V. Budget

- 2023-2024

- District is experiencing a budget deficit and are exploring options for cuts. ESSER funds are disappearing at the end of Spring 2024.
- Attendance Impacts
 - For two years, schools were not being held accountable for attendance. This has changed and now Crockett has a deficit because of our ADA (93.9%), the lowest it has been since before pandemic.
 - Jun 1, 2023 The Board of Managers will step in.
 - All Crockett projections and plans, for the next school year, were done taking into consideration this deficit.
 - Dr. Clark explained which budgets were used to pay all our staff.

VI. Staffing

- 3 Confirmed Vacancies
 - Two of the vacancies are being used to balance the budget and to avoid staffing cuts.
- 2 Anticipated Vacancies
 - Team of three for fourth grade next year vs. four teachers this year. One class will be self-contained (Bilingual/ ESL).
 - Fifth grade will continue with three teachers, however, one class will be self-contained.
 - Dr. Clark explained the difference between bilingual and dual language education, and how enrollment for Crockett has shifted showing a significant decrease in the students identifying as emergent bilingual learners.

VII. Updates

- SDMC Members 2023-2024
 - Member terms are two years of service. Some members have met the requirement; therefore, the committee will have some adjustments to those serving as voting members next year.
- Taj Mahal
 - Dr. Clark mentioned some families have expressed confusion about the alignment of the Taj Mahal area to Crockett.
 - Ms. Pierce explained the history behind.
 - Ms. Nina explained the family atmosphere Crockett has. She likes the idea of having it but agrees some remodeling needs to be done.
 - Ms. Kartadjoemena shared some ideas about the use of the wall next to the PE area: 'Cover it with tiles made by families, fund-raising style'.
 - Dr. V: Having a plaque explaining the history.
 - Thoughts to consider: Ensuring an inclusive environment and that any decisions made are about the students we serve.
