August PD Suggestions: after viewing R360, Running records, and District Snapshot data, the SDMC committee agreed upon PD focused on developing language acquisition for our EL'S. The data analysis shows that our ELs are not showing the expected growth. Most of our 4th and 5th grade TIER III scholars are ELs. Our ELs are not on grade level and will need additional intervention beginning in September. During the August Pre-Service and on Early Dismissals, the staff will participate in PD to effectively impact second language learners.

Master Schedule: There is a need for additional focused intervention to meet the needs of our scholars. Therefore, the Master schedule will reflect focused intervention during the day. Each grade level will have a built-in intervention period. The scholars will receive support based on the 2021 EOY and BOY data. The results of the intervention will be collected and discussed during weekly PLC'S.

SDMC: will be trained this summer on the new SIP template. After the training, the SDMC will complete the work during our administration retreat scheduled in July. The new template is more user-friendly and will allow easy access to the information created in the document.

Scholar round-up: Due to COVID-19 and other unforeseen events, our enrollment dropped from 590 to 497.

We need to implement an intense marketing plan to reclaim all scholars zoned to Benbrook. To assist in recapturing our scholars, parents will have opportunities to enroll daily during the summer months. An assigned employee will be available for parents to enroll their scholars. Enrollment information will be sent out through the school's automated system and posted on the marquee.
