- Enrollment 821 Enrollment is increasing year to year
- Snapshot Date October 25, 2024
 - 27.7% low SES in SY 23-24 to 21.1% for SY 24-25 % of low SES students decreased from prior year; trend that seems to be consistent with the district at the time of viewing of district data
- Current Average Daily Attendance: 98.1% MIMS student attendance is the currently the HIGHEST in the West Division.
 - YTD Estimated Funding Lost Due to Absences: \$15,365.55
