SIP Milestones: The SIP 2018 – 2019 Milestones were reviewed and discussed. In **reading** All of the grades are on track except 2nd Bilingual math. On the most recent failure report there is a concern with the number of scholars not showing mastery. To address the concern, the scholars will receive after school support three times during the week. After looking at the **math** data the committee recommend the use of Education Galaxy and RMC to monitor student progress. The SDMC noticed that writing is still a concern for our 4th grade scholars. The committee suggested the hiring of an outside company to do push in intervention as well as Saturday tutorials for scholars who failed the snapshot and DLA. The committee suggested we print the student history report from On Track to monitor student progress.

Lead4ward: According to the 2018 -2019 SIP all classroom teacher will use the Lead4ward strategies to increase student engagement. After observation the administrative team findings indicated 50% of the teacher were using the strategies. Therefore, it was the committee's suggestion to create a Lead4ward monthly calendar to assist the staff with implementation of the Lead4ward strategies.

Safety: The front gate continues to be a problem. The doors are constantly left opened. The Plant Operators submits work orders to correct the problem. One suggestion was to place a call box on the main door. All visitors will be required to buzz in twice in order to gain entrance. Mr. Martinez the school's Plant Operator will submit a work order for the additional call box.
