Pro's and Con's What type of feedback from parents - What questions should we ask parents?
Parent Input: Parent translations have been better. Homework has been an issue for parents - need more support parents do not know how to help kids. Parents may feel nervous about approaching a teacher to admit they do not know how to help kids. Parents need homework workshops and need to see more examples of how to help their kids. When parents google translations sometimes it doesn't translate equally. Parents rely on examples from the internet on ways to help their child.
Pre-K input – behavior is a concern when they do not understand what teachers are saying they go to certain behaviors. Focus in one language first is a suggestion
Teacher: There are children who find it very easy to acquire another language and then there are students that have no support at home that have behavior issues and really struggle. Teacher gave input about her thoughts about 50/50. Something that is very important is that the teacher is on the right page and committed to Dual Language. Implementation is key. Support and training is necessary to be able to implement. Teacher talked about how important for teachers to know the PLDs and how to grown and support ELLs. Vocabulary is important to be taught to every student especially our ELLs.
Parent: Voiced her concern about how vocabulary is difficult for students.
Parent – would like to see HFW words in the upper grades.
