#### Quick Updates and Celebrations

- Love Fun Run was a huge success! Thank you to PTO for their organizing and running of the event!
- Through the funds raised at the Fun Run and at the upcoming Fall Festival combined with school funding,
  all grade level wishlists will be able to be cleared!
- Enrollment: 345 (Above 315 Projection)
- Attendance Rate Goal: 97% 94.2% for Cycle 1
  - Not there yet. Currently
  - WRS will be calling families not attending.
  - Lots of sickness impacting both students and staff.
- Facilities Update
  - On a practical level, working on campus security. Securing doors, additional cameras, front office processes for visitors, fire drills, secure drills, etc.
  - No update yet regarding AC chillers out front. November projection for permanent fix to be installed.
  - Love has been selected by the District of lead water testing. Notices were sent home this week.

#### Staffing Update

- As of today, 100% positions are fully staffed with a certified teacher.
  - Including TA's for SpEd and PreK
- The new appraisal process (T-TESS) is underway for all teachers.
