Spark Park Renovation Project

- Review of Current State of the Park Cheryl Huffman
 - Field has many divots that impede safe play
 - Play structure and dome are in safe working condition
 - Stage has broken boards
 - Castle requires additional coating
 - Water pump is currently broken
- Review of Renovation Options & Cost
 - Field cost estimate is between \$50,000 \$150,000
 - \$50,000 will fix divots, irrigation, and includes reseeding. It also includes soccer goals.
 - Committee leans towards the \$50,000 cost to ensure safety, but believe that upkeep of more substantial updates is unlikely to be sustainable and worth the cost.
 - Addition of a larger castle would cost about \$25,000
 - Replacing the deck could cost \$50,000
 - Cost of a new playground structure to replace the current one would be about \$200,000
 - Addition of a 2-5 yr old focused structure would be about \$65,000
 - Chill spinners would cost about \$10,000
 - Gaga pit would cost approx \$5,000 for the kit and can be installed by volunteers
 - Installation of swings would cost about \$15,000
 - Jumpers would cost about \$15,000
- Committee Agreement on Priorities
 - o Field renovation \$50,000
 - o Installation of swings \$15,000

- Expand cement padding around the checkerboard area to allow for multipurpose use including four square Community volunteer project
- Add larger castle and repair current smaller version \$25,000
- O Demolish deck \$5,000
- o \$ chair spinners \$12,000
- Gaga pit kit \$5,000
- Install jumpers for obstacle course \$15,000
- o Install obstacle course \$80,000

- Ms. Huffman will draft a plan with the priorities listed.
- Ms. Ownby will provide an updated fundraising goal estimate.
- Bass will communicate fundraising goal to the community.





- Front office staff should speak to others with respect and not be rude most of the time. Edited for anonymity.
- Front office staff is rude
- Front reception needs retraining on providing good "customer service,"
 particularly at peak hours and in stressful situations.
- Office staff could definitely improve with their customer service.
- One of the front desk staff is super rude and her customer service is seriously lacking. I always regret when I have to speak with her - it makes for a terrible experience. Please teach your staff to be kind. It takes just as much energy to be rude as it does to be nice. The Principal is also not friendly - she treats my kids like they are not worth her time.
- Translation: The other principal was nicer to the parents and greeted us.
- The treatment of kids varies from class to class at Baker. In my observation, kids whose parents are active on campus have an advantage in terms of how they are treated and the opportunities afforded them.
- I believe concerns raised by families should be addressed, at least individually. I am very concerned that an issue about inappropriate language used by an upper elementary teacher toward a student in their classroom has not been addressed (three weeks after this issue was raised in writing.) Crude language used toward students is never acceptable.
- *Translation:* I would like the **quality of the food** to improve and so much food waste by the students to be avoided...I wish you could organize a better eating plan, that's all, thank you. *Edited for brevity*.
- There should be responsive communication from administration when a parent communicates with them about a concern they have for their child.


Lack of communication is not a professional way to lead a school.

- Morning drop-off on Windsor is precarious. I've seen parents park right in front of the door, leave their car door open, walk around the car, open their child's door, get them out of the car, and wait for their child to enter the building. Edited for brevity.
- Opportunities to purchase event tickets online close too early.
- Had 3 incidents early in school career at Wilson/baker where racist things
 were said to my child by other students
- I have heard of incidents where black children were disciplined more than other kids.
- He's been **bullied** and haven't had **nothing done** about it
- I think there could be better community resources. There is no
 transportation in the area for the kids that live near Lanier that could actually
 need it. Also I think there could be more parental involvement with things,
 such as the school play. We could hold more fundraisers for costumes or help
 with props.
- I would like my 2nd grader to have a teacher assigned to her class
- The **tardy and absent policy** could use some revision




- 1. My son enjoys his time with his teacher. He feels welcomed, heard and valued. She has helped him to find a place in the classroom, share his interests and challenges him to learn new things. Her weekly emails helps me to have school-home conversations about his learning and fun. 2. I'm unsure of the formal process to address concerns or where to find this information.
- I rarely have a concern that cannot be addressed with our teacher, front office staff, or the campus leadership team.

- Above and beyond, this has been an amazing experience for the 10 years we have attended
- I know that I will be directed to the right person to answer my questions, but I am not certain that there is information available on websites or a clear description of certain processes. I usually just call the front desk and go from there.

GROWS

- Our teacher frequently doesn't respond to emails or messages on ClassTag. I
 have little knowledge of what is happening in the classroom.
- When going to the office to speak to the principal I feel like the staff tries
 every way to get me to just email the principal instead. I feel I am always
 given a blanket statement with all email responses from principal and vice
 principal.
- I don't know if there is a process for handling parent concerns. It hasn't been communicated to parents.
- Sometimes you have to dig for connection at Baker. I always find higher level admin team and principal very open and willing to talk. **But it's hard to get to them sometimes for some families.**
- It took several attempts before we could book an appointment with my son's teacher to address his performance in math.
- I am **routinely ignored** and unable to get answers to even basic questions
- HISD information in general is not user friendly. There is a lot of conflicting, contradictory, or simply confusing content throughout the HISD site and related school sites.
- Haven't felt open to talk to principal. Pre-recorded phone messages previous principal left for parents helped me feel more connected.
- I don't know what the current process is for addressing concerns, so I can't give a valid response.
- Again some front desk staff and the principle need to work on their customer service skills.
- I always feel like the staff members are scowling at me.




GLOWS

- We very much appreciate all the efforts of the teachers and the administration, and hope to continue to improve the dialogue at about the students' performance and how we can work together to make a baker one of the best schools in HISD.
- 1. I'm taking the approach that no news is good news when it comes to his behavior and academics. 2. I'm not sure what important decisions means
- We have an amazing teacher. I know he has a lot of kids in the class and does his best to communicate.
- We are **very happy with our teacher**. She's kind and fun, but also firm and sets clear expectations. She encourages her students to push themselves while giving them the tools to succeed. My **child loves going to school** every day and I trust our teacher to help her keep growing and learning.
- Our team has worked so hard to support my child, we are meeting all of our goals
- I think my kids are doing well so it hasn't been an issue I have had to keep up with

GROWS

I have had several conversations with teacher and co-teacher about increasing their communication with me. If I do not check in with them, I am not alerted about anything. Whether it be behavior or academics. There are certain serious behaviors from other kids which I feel should have been communicated to all parents of the class but wasn't. I am not happy with the communication at all this year.

- **Dialogue about behavior and grades varies from class to class.** Some teachers are great about it, some are completely non communicative. Current classroom teacher does a good job.
- More clarification is needed about use of digital resources provided by HISD to supplement/enhance instruction.
- I don't feel like grades are imputed in a timely manner, therefore problems cannot be addressed BEFORE report cards. I've reviewed progress reports with 1 or 0 grades for a subject. I also thought there was a minimum amount of grades per subject. Also, if there is only 1 summative assessment per subject, at more %, doesn't seem like accurate representation for a subject.
- The shift to Canvas has been very difficult for teachers, students, and parents. We still don't have a clear understanding of the system which often makes helping challenging.
- Sending the Pawprint earlier would be helpful
- I have never received information on my child's academic progress
- We know very little about what is happening in class. However, our teacher is new and communication is ticking up, which is great.
- Don't know if my child is being pushed to excel. It feels like the community aspect of Baker is higher than the academic excellence.
- Information regarding students progress was vague.
- Based on this question about whether our teachers update us on academic progress, I just remembered to go log into the parent portal. I am surprised now to see my kid currently shows a NP in social studies. I had not heard that yet from her teacher, and I am unsure if my kid is aware either. There are only two days left in this grading period. Yikes.
- I think there should be scheduled parent teacher conferences.
- I do like class tag, but I have no idea what's going on with my kid or if they're making progress, unless their failing.
- Regarding school and district communications, we find that the district over-communicates/duplicates information (phone call, emails, etc) which creates "alarm fatigue", while our school typically under communicates information from the classroom level.
- I have found since starting at Baker in 2018 that we need to take initiative to solicit specific information about our child's academic progress and behavior from the teacher. Without soliciting, we would receive the report card home quarterly, but there is rarely dialogue. On one occasion there was email about a concerning issue, but otherwise we don't receive feedback about behavior, positive or negative. I also am uncertain about how to help my child improve academically without using the computer-based recommendations.
- We are uncertain how the Montessori curriculum and the state testing standards are being instructed in parallel and often are confused about learning expectations
