- a) Attendance
 - i) 89% attendance rate for the 1st semester. It is sufficiently below the goal of 98%. We are contributing the dip due to Covid-19, virtual students not logging on, teachers not coding correctly, and unreachable students. After three attempts of contacting parents and/or students with no success, the students are administrative withdrawn. If the students reappear, Woodson re-enroll students if space is available.
- b) Discipline no major discipline issues; All issues centered around unauthorized movement in the classroom or failure to wear mask correctly. Repeated infractions result in students being place on virtual learning only during a probationary period.
- c) Student Achievement Based on previous scores on district and campus common assessments, the students are demonstrating progress but are sufficient short of reaching meets and masters.
- d) Personnel Updates Due to Covid-19 and resignations, the school is experiencing multiple changes in staffing, especially in the second-grade and third-grade programs. The grade levels have been revamped to reflect a 3-way split for the best interest and academic growth of the scholars. We also hired an additional teacher assistant for SpEd and continue to search for additional personnel for the SpEd department.
