<b>Budgets Update</b>	We have exhausted our money for material for the 2022-2023 school year. We are confident that we will conclude the year with all budget strands exhausted with a maximum of \$100 total money in our budget to close the fiscal year 22-23.
<b>School Budget for 2023-2024 school year</b>	The latest budget meeting increased our GF to \$167,000. We have set aside our Opportunity Culture money. Out of caution, the excess money was placed in General Supplies instead of strategically allocating the money out of precaution. We are cautious and will delay hiring hourly personnel for Nurse Support and Intervention/IAT support until the new leadership confirms our budget.
<b>Opportunity Culture</b>	We have completed the process of hiring our OC team. Our design plan was confirmed. The general staff of Farias ECC was informed during the Staff meeting on May 25.
<b>TEA Intervention</b>	We are waiting on the official announcement of the new leadership on June 1. We will continue working on the main thing.
<b>Safety Update</b>	Safety meeting conducted this month. Main topic of discussion was the school threats on social media. Our goal is to maintain our current safety procedures and to remind the teachers to be alerted.
<b>Enrollment Update</b>	We are nearing our projection of 385 for the 2023-2024 school year. We are about 85 students close to reaching our projection.
<b>PTO Update</b>	PTO is conducting their final event with the Mother/Son dance on May 26. Funds will be used towards the end of the year student celebrations on May 30 and May 31.
<b>Upcoming Student Activities</b>	PTO is sponsoring the student EOY activities to celebrate the end of the year. This replaces the traditional end of year parties. Cafeteria will be serving lunch which includes hamburgers or hot dogs.
<b>New for 2023-2024</b>	Our focus next year is on building our intellectual program. PLCs will focus on best practices, student growth documentation, and understanding the new TX PK guidelines. Reflection sheets were passed out to every team member with the expectation of completion by the end of the school year. We also announced the new school theme of BE
