• Teacher Concerns:

- Communicate when Restrooms are closed for all staff and students to limit movement
- SEL forms & Behavior Tracker:
 - Teachers do not feel that the comments are being read on the return forms



- They also feel some students are showing up late to class to get their form: Time stamping the forms helps make sure that they get to class on time.
- Issue tracking students once on campus until in classroom.
- More Morning Staff to handle inside traffic
- Main Office handing out Tardy Passes like Saturday Tutorials.
- 7th Grade is LATE for Leaving Lunch, issues for Electives who have mixed classes.
- Teachers Picking up Students for Lunch:
 - It doesn't work and takes too long.
 - Randall feels that currently we need to monitor students, due to fights, horseplaying, etc.
- Re-do the Hallway directions 6th getting trampled by 8th graders (especially for 8th lunch)
 - Flip 8th direction or 6th was suggested
- Behavior (8th):
 - Teachers discussed different teaching strategies that may help.
