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### • 2022-2023 – Master Schedule

- O Principal Bailey went through Dual Credit opportunities for the 22-23 school year. She indicated through the commitment of teachers and community members we believe we are in a good space to move forward to offer Dual Credit courses for the 22-23 school year. She indicated that this work began prior to her stepping in as interim and together we have worked to continue moving it forward. The following courses are scheduled for offering:
  - Law elective course
  - Dual Credit Chemistry
  - Music Appreciation course
- o There was a question posed by Dr. Renfro asking if dual credit would take place in lieu of regular chemistry. (Response: No, we will offer regular chemistry and dual credit chemistry)
