APEX Credits/Tutorials

Several Students have received 3 or more credits thus far this school year. As It stands right now, HSAA has quadrupled the amount of credits students have received over the past years. More students are engaging in APEX since having student/parent conferences. More students are participating in Saturday tutorials, however, we would like more to attend. Students attend virtually and we have about 25 students that participate on a weekly basis. We would like to have at least 40 to 50 participate on a weekly basis.

Accountability

We currently have 29 students that count for TELPAS, however, the required 25 students may or may not count because of previous testing years. We're doing well in reading per the DLA, however, we still need improvement in math. Changes have been made in the math classrooms and it's currently producing better results as witnessed by exit ticket data.

Attendance Incentives/Wraparound Support

Attendance currently sits at 73%. The school needs to increase incentives to help improve attendance. Transportation problems are a consistent issue. Moving up the start time is a possible resolution. Meetings have occurred to bring in more Wraparound Supports.
