## 1. State of Chavez

- a. Graduates
  - i. We have a little over 500 students that will graduate; 30 in credit recovery right now; several that will be in summer school virtually and working on APEX as well. We should have around 600 after summer school and credit recovery

## b. Budget

- i. We have budgeted for 2700 students for next year
- c. Literacy
  - i. We have a handful of teachers who will be helping with this as well as with instructional focus, but literacy will be a focus for everyone next year.
- d. Social Emotional Support/Scholarship and testing support/Collaborative Learning
  - i. We have hired more counselors and wrap around folks in order to help with this on our campus and they will be housed in every house...to assist with student needs
- e. Scholarship support
  - i. We are going to move these folks into houses as well in order for them to be more accessible to the students
- f. Upcoming School Year- Calendar
  - i. There will be the same amount of days...but it could be spread out a bit throughout the year...so the school year could go longer. This is not set in stone...as it gets finalized we will get that info out
- g. Summer School
  - i. This will be virtual. It will be June 8-July 2 from 10-2 Monday through Thursday
- h. School Availability
  - i. Tuesday and Thursday it will be open from 8:30-12:30 and you can come by appt only. There will be a skeleton staff there that includes some folks in the front to answer calls, the nurse, an AP
  - ii. We are looking to get some fillable PDFs for registration so folks can do this all online
- i. Stability in Hallways
  - i. We are keeping the hallways as their grade levels and won't be moving that. C and D hall will be freshman, A house will be sophomores, E hall will be junior, and B hall will be for seniors

- ii. Admin and clerks will move instead of all the teachers
- j. Openings
  - i. We didn't have very many to fill this year, only about 8! We have been able to fill the majority of those. We do have a couple more to fill, but we are looking pretty well as far as open positions. We created a position for our dyslexia students and are just paying for it in house. We also have a couple teachers that will be going to training this summer to assist with helping with our dyslexic students.
- k. Career Pathways
  - i. 6 of our teachers will have leadership roles in helping with data, instruction, and literacy with all of our teachers

## 2. Parade

- a. On May 26<sup>th</sup> we had a parade/check in for our seniors. It lasted from 10-3/4 about 3 more hours
- b. Thanks to Mr. Izaguirre for DJ'ing for the event!! It was awesome to have him there
- 3. June 5<sup>th</sup>
  - a. This will last from 4-8. Official program from 6-7, but seniors can start showing up at 4 and can stay till 7. It will be held in the football field.
  - b. This is for ALL seniors. This does not mean that they have actually graduated if they attend this celebration.
  - c. There will be a photo booth and music and snowcones for kids. There will be two drop offs, one for kids to park if they are driving themselves and parking and one drop off for students that will be dropped off by their families. No families are allowed to attend. This is ONLY for students and the staff that will helping. We will do about a 30 min presentation for our students from 6-6:30 and then at 6:30, we will project the city-wide presentation on the screen that will be in front of where all the chairs will be set up.
- 4. Virtual Graduation
  - a. We will only have a virtual graduation this year. We will not be able to do this face to face.
  - b. June 14<sup>th</sup> at 1pm for everyone across the district. Everything will be pre-recorded and ready to go for that date. This will be a live link and available for 1 year to access.
