## **Budget Updates**

- Total Funding for 2018 Principal Turek met with Mr. Mark Smith to request additional funds for next year. Targeted assistance grants to help with things like intervention but not to pay salaries.
- Faculty and Staff impact After losing magnet funds (267,608.71) 12 teachers' salaries were affected because of split funding. We are losing 1 Admin, 1 teacher, 2 members of the support staff.
  - Take from the outside circle 1<sup>st</sup>
  - Special Ed budget is separate
  - PTO has a plan in place to help support with special programs
- Enrollment updates for 2018/2019
  - 784 students projected for 2018/2019
  - 730 currently as of 5/8/2018
  - What will happen if we don't meet enrollment???
  - Kinder #'s are very low
  - 45% qualified GT last year and currently only 20% qualified and processed this year
  - \$3,452 per student (\$186,408)
- PTO Support
  - Herod Hero Breakfast
  - Classroom Grants
  - \$150 Teacher Aide/Assistance
  - \$500 to cover student incentives
  - PTO will cover teacher incentives for example gifts and special dinners/lunch
