Meeting Agenda & Minutes

1. Celebrations!

- We survived moving classrooms! Thank you to everyone for being so flexible and patient given the time constraints!
- We held meetings with our struggling virtual students and were able to make plans for them to be successful!

2. Fall Parent & Staff Surveys

Attendees split into two groups on Microsoft Teams to discuss the fall semester parent and staff survey responses. Each group was tasked with identifying strengths, areas of growth, and 2 action steps.

- Staff Survey Findings:
 - Glow: Building a positive school culture even during Covid 19
 - o Grow: Teaching time vs. testing time seems to be 40%/60%
 - Action step 1: Teachers will have PLC time to plan vertically with other grade levels.
 - o Action step 2: Teacher will utilize grade level funds for student needs.
- Parent Survey Findings:

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- o Glow: Families were very satisfied with overall school communication.
- Grow: Teacher response time on ClassDojo
- Action step 1: Dedicate more class time to small group instruction.
- Action step 2: Ensure teacher response time on ClassDojo is between 24 48 hours.

3. Partnership with St. James Family Center

- Love received funds from the Teacher & School Leader Incentive Grant to increase community engagement.
- Upcoming action steps:
 - Community walk:
 - Student home visits to pass out materials and encourage attendance
 - Requesting staff volunteers
 - Parent workshops

4. Additional Funding Proposal

The campus applied for additional funding to cover the following:

- \$8,000 K-5 tutorials be begin 2nd week of February
- \$4,000 in-house writing PD for 2-4
- \$19,172 3-5 curriculum resources
