SDMC September 9 Minutes

Meeting opened with introductions and explanation of everyone's role.

- I. Reviewed the School Improvement Plan: We reviewed the Needs assessment, reviewed the data and strategies for Reading and Math
 - a. Marcucci: PK intervention time. Using Head Start teachers to provide that extra support
 - b. Parents asked about providing incentives to students. Benavidez Bucks and a school store for good behavior.
- II. School Safety: reviewed the Covid safety plan: We are using two rooms for lunch: cafeteria and gym and dividing the classes. This has helped to keep the numbers controlled. Explained about mask usage and we are still providing masks to each student. Enrichment is wiping down inbetween each change of class. We also added wipes on our list of supplies from parents. We will have hand sanitizer in every classroom and all of the entrances.
- III. HB4545: Accelerated Instruction that is provided to students. Students who did not meet standard will receive 30 hours of accelerated tutorials. Families will be contacted for individual meetings to explain the plan for their student. We have until the end of summer school to complete the 30 hours.
- IV. Wrap Around: Receiving donations almost daily for the Benavidez Food Pantry, supplies and clothing. About 3000-5000 Afghani families are expected to arrive and we need to be ready to support these families. We are working with the Alliance for translations. Benavidez is the "HUB" for resources in the Sharpstown Area. Different schools come to Benavidez for support.
