Updates from Sebba – Budget, Staffing, Enrollment, Purchasing, and Instruction

- Budget Budget looks good for the rest of the year to cover hourlies, should have money for a couple more Montessori trainings and to purchase uniforms for next year

- Staffing: new hire for Ms. Dreher's classroom (Jasmine Mendivil); Ms. Salgado has departed
- Recruitment: Our big magnet fair is Saturday at Heights HS
 - Discussion of recruitment for middle school. Need for middle school because our current enrollment is too low to sustain four teachers in the middle school. Will have two booths at the fair. Discussion of impact of integrating 6th graders into UE classrooms—changes classroom culture to have new students. SDMC supportive of the move to integrate new 6th graders but want to be thoughtful about how and the maximum number. Discussion of orientation to support transition.
- **Input needed**: \$8000 for campus capital (furniture, technology)
 - Suggestions: PTO president suggested teacher lounge update; Sebba suggested lower el tables and chairs (echoed by teachers); also suggested by teachers Montessori shelving to replace wobbly shelves
 - Suggested contacting parents
