### Academic goals and progress

- Instruction:
  - Priorities for the year are-
    - Transparent Classroom implementation
      - Ms. White explained what Transparent Classroom is and how it benefits teachers.
    - Eureka Math integration
      - Ms. Sebba reviewed plans for Eureka.
      - Ms. Scott asked about Carnegie in the middle school. SDMC discussed the reasons for a decrease in STAAR scores for 8th grade last year.

- Budget/staffing/enrollment:

  - Will prioritize current staffing model
- Purchasing:
  - Holding off until budget settles
  - Need for online resource to support writing constructed responses
