### Minutes

4:15-Meeting called to order. In attendance were Principal Lopez, Dean Vela, Mrs. Minnock (PTO President), Mrs. Pillot (Parent rep), Mrs. Correa (Parent rep), Mrs. Epperson, Mr. Gonsoulin, Mr. Lacy, Mrs. Levenson.

4:15-4:25 End of year updates. Parents asked questions about 8<sup>th</sup> grade celebration. There will be a continued focus on social distancing during all transitions. Preparations for an increase in face-to-face attendance are in place.

4:25-4:35 Instructional updates. Continued focus on classroom instruction to end the year strong. Parental thoughts on waiver days-difficult for some parents to keep students at home during testing days. Review by team noted that similar testing structure won't be needed next year.

4:35-4:50 Backpacks/uniforms/lockers. Reviewed that clear/mesh backpacks may not be used next year. Lockers may not be used (so many students could have laptops for them-no need for lockers). Hallway movement and stair usage will continue for 21-22 school year and will be enforced. PTO wanted to consider the idea of changing school uniform color for 7<sup>th</sup> grade only because of a shortage of yellow supplies. No final decision was made.
