This program is like students learning to ride a bike because they are going through supports that will ultimately lead them to reading. Most of the kids are in extension, 25/32
students have moved to extensions. Students in 2nd grade only had 14 students not pass the HFW test.

1st grade has a larger number of students not passing the HFW (51)

As an action plan we have implemented more interventions for students with the goal of lowering the number of students not passing the test.

Amplify

It is a high quality Tier 1 curriculum that is helping students write and though it has not been an easy curriculum to implement. Valley West is the top performing school in the district amongst the piloting Amplify campuses according to Interim Assessments and Unit Assessments. It has a lot to do with teacher and leadership moves. Looking for 5 point gain on the meets level.
