

Mrs. Adams called the meeting to order at 4:30 pm. Mrs. Adams welcomed everyone to the 1st quarter SDMC meeting. The committee members introduced themselves as: Principal, Mrs. Adams, Assistant Principal, Mr. Simmons, Campus Testing Coordinator, Dr. Grover, Instructional Coach, Mrs. Peters, ELA teacher, Mr. Victorian, Instructional Coach-ELA, Mrs. Muhammad, Social Studies Teacher, Dr. Owens, Special Education Employment Rep, Ms. Bradley, and non-instructional staff, Ms. Garcia. Community members, Mr. Bailey and Ms. Smith did not attend.

Dr. Grover read the old minutes from the 4th quarter meeting of the 2021-2022 school year.

Mrs. Adams noted that the community members did not attend the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter meeting. Ms. Adams discussed a replacement for our parent member.

Mrs. Adams discussed board goals. She stated, board goal one pertains to ELA. Board goal two is related to Math. Board goal three is associated



with CCMR, and board goal four/five addresses special populations.

Board goals indicate we will increase literacy and math levels. ELA will increase achievement by 15% and growth points by 20%. Algebra I will increase student performance to 75% approaches, 46% meets, and 20% masters.

Ms. Adams stated we are holding our weight as a campus in regards to instructional outcomes and student academic success. Mrs. Adams said the campus improvement plan shows our students are growing. She also stated the school will increase growth through small groups.

Mrs. Muhammad asked if the attendance rates had improved. Mrs. Adams stated attendance was still not at pre-pandemic rates. Yet, she noted the attendance board goal is to increase attendance from 86% to a minimum of 90%.

Board goal five address closing the gap with EL learners, special needs students, economically disadvantage and continuous/non-continuous students. North Forest High will increase the percentage of EL students meeting progress on TELPAS to 43% by the conclusion of the 2022-2023 school year. The committee agreed to keep the gaols as is.

CCMR will increase its certification rate from 79% to 85%. Board goal five also addresses the progress of SPED students. The committee agreed the goal needs to be measurable. The parent and community involvement goal is to increase participation by 20%. The committee agreed. However, the Title I Coordinator was added as staff responsible for monitoring.

Biology will improve overall student performance by 75% approaches, 40% meets, and 11% masters. The committee agreed to keep the goals as is. The Social Studies goal was changed to increase approaches from 68% to 86%. The committee agreed. Dr. Grover motioned to improve Campus Improvement Plan and Dr. Owens 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion.
